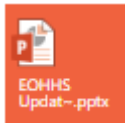

EOHHS data collection going forward:

- All agencies that oversee facilities/congregate care sites continue to report **resident/state staff data into SharePoint site daily** (weekend catch-up can occur on Monday if preferred)
- All agencies should continue to report **state staff cases to HR** (even if the individual works for a facility or congregate care site)
- All agencies should continue to **collect vendor staff and client-level data** (outside of facilities/congregate care) internally but **do not need to report it to EOHHS**
- EOEAs should report **ALR data weekly** (on Wednesdays) to EOHHS
- Agencies **do not submit daily tracker** to EOHHS going forward
- Agencies **do not submit RYG staff reports** to HR (data is being reported through new SharePoint reporting)
- Soldiers' Homes should continue reporting additional data to Comms team

- Daily tracker no longer needs to be submitted to EOHHS
- RYG staff reports no longer need to be submitted to HR (data is being reported through new SharePoint reporting)
- **Soldiers' Homes should continue reporting data to Comms team, need to decide if Shattuck/Tewksbury maintain this separate reporting as well**
